## OFFICE ORDER

With a view to realize outstanding dues from consumers and in the event that the consumer is not able to pay the outstanding dues, and on reasonable grounds that it is in the interest of the Corporation to do so, and in line with the Office Order U/O No. GAP/86/2005/50 Dated 13<sup>th</sup> December 2006 read with U/O No GAP/ 86/2005/51 dated 15<sup>th</sup> January 2007, the Chairman Cum Managing Director, MeECL, hereby authorises the following Officers at different levels for waiver of Delayed Payment Charge (DPC) and recovery of the balance outstanding dues in installment (after waiver) on receipt of written application from the consumer as indicated below:

1. The Executive Engineer (Revenue) may grant and approve the waiver of 60% of Delayed Payment Charge to all the consumers having an outstanding dues and whose total DPC is up to Rs 10,000.00 (Rupees ten thousand). Further the Officer may also grant payment in installment basis with a maximum number of 2 (Two) installments on the approved Delayed Payment Charge.
2. The Chief Executive Officer concerned may grant and approve the waiver of 60% of Delayed Payment Charge to all the consumers having an outstanding dues and whose total DPC is above Rs 10,000.00 (Rupees ten thousand) and within Rs 20,000.00 (Rupees twenty thousand). Further, the Officer may also grant payment in installment basis with a maximum number of 2 (Two) installments on the approved Delayed Payment Charge.
3. The Additional Chief Engineer concerned may grant and approve the waiver of 60% of Delayed Payment Charge to all the consumers having an outstanding dues and whose total DPC is above Rs 20,000.00 (Rupees twenty thousand) and within Rs 50,000.00 (Rupees fifty thousand). Further, the Officer may also grant payment in installment basis with a maximum number of 2 (Two) installments on the approved Delayed Payment Charge.
