Pre-Bid Queries:-**Reply**

(A) Clause 1.16 "Manpower" shall include supply/engagement of manpower for maintenance of Electricity Transmission/Generation / Distribution utility directly/ or in lieu of services rendered of maintenance of line/ substations etc.

Reason: The same will ensure the experience of engaging manpower with primary knowledge of Electrical, lines/ substations where safety and reliability is the "quality" of such manpower.

(B) Clause 1.19 shall include "Firm engaging skilled/ unskilled manpower for Power sector utility for maintenance of lines/ substations directly or in lieu of their services rendered in any Electrical utility in NE state/ Meghalaya"

Reason: We all aware that in Meghalaya, the majority of the work force in service sector dependent on Government services. The new concept of outsourcing manpower in specialised jobs like Power sector is emerging in nature in this State. To restrict the same only for firm having experience of supply of any kind of manpower will not only defeat the objectives of experience of supplying "quality" manpower in any Government utility but also to reduce the competition and debar the certain firms already having experience of engagement of such manpower in Power utility as a part of their annual maintenance contract (AMC) for Electrical lines and they have valid electrical license also.

Moreover, as the evaluation process is 80% quality and 20% price, the quality of manpower services cannot be any kind of supply of skilled/ unskilled manpower, but it shall be specific in nature understanding the requirement of power sector is totally different as reiterated above.

To avoid such restrictive clauses in the tender, by modifying the above the competition will not be limited to only one/ two local firms.

(C) 3.5 shall include "firm having experience of engaging manpower in Power sector directly or indirectly as a part of Annual maintenance contract or otherwise of lines/ substation and other establishment related to Power sector".

Reason: The "Similar Contract/ Work" defined as any supply of manpower in Government sector. It is understood that the quality of manpower (which is carrying 80% weightage) required those having experience in this sector rather giving normal manpower supply in Government offices which is general and "quality" not reflecting from such eligibility criteria.

In view of the above, it is requested that to maintain the quality of skilled and unskilled manpower in Power sectors eligibility criteria and at least 50% marks shall be assigned to such firm having experience of directly and indirectly experience of supplying manpower in line/ substation maintenance.

However, we have observed that this has been removed in the new RFP. We would like to understand whether this category will be floated in a separate tender or if it has been excluded entirely.</p> <p>2. Format-B-Undertaking for Trade License Submission at a Later Date: As our organisation belongs to a Scheduled Tribe, we respectfully submit that the requirement for a trade license does not apply to us under the provisions applicable to tribal entities in Meghalaya. Kindly confirm whether a self-declaration will suffice in place of the said undertaking.</p> <p>3. Format -C-Declaration Regarding Non-Blacklisting/ Non-Debarment: We seek your clarification on whether this declaration is to be submitted on our official letterhead or on a Rs. 100/- non-judicial stamp paper. The RFP mentions clause 3.7, but the format or medium of submission is unclear.</p> <p>4. Power of Attorney (POA): We also request clarification on whether a Power of Attorney is mandatory for submission, especially in cases where the authorised signatory is the Proprietorship firm.</p> <p>We would be grateful for your clarification on the above points to enable us to submit our proposal in full compliance with the tender requirements.</p>	<p>As per RFP stating ‘Any other’ category.</p> <p>Not required for tribal of Meghalaya as quoted in the State Act.</p> <p>Should be in a Rs. 100/- Non-judicial stamp paper.</p> <p>Whatever the Power of Attorney defines, the authorized signatory for proprietorship firms are not required if proprietor is appearing self.
