(i) Asking work experience in the state of Meghalaya will restrict healthy competition. (ii) Also, as the projects are funded by Central Govt and as per clause No. 3.9 -Pre-qualification Modes of procurement of Procurement Manual (published by Govt of India, Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure), "Pre-qualification Bids (PQBs) should meet the norms of transparency, fairness, and maintenance of competition." In view of the above, it is requested to remove this clause. Alternatively, bidder's work experience in hilly terrain or Northeastern (NE) region may be sought.	"Experience in Meghalaya or North-East region or any state of India.
3	2.1.7 The bidder should possess a valid Electrical License of Meghalaya only. In case the bid is submitted by Joint Venture, all partners should possess the same.	In case the bid is submitted by Joint Venture, it is requested to change the clause that the Lead Partner should possess the valid Electrical License of Meghalaya.	The bidder should meet the necessary license class requirements as applicable for the execution of works in this RFB. However, in case the bidder does not hold the license for the given State, then the bidder should possess the equivalent license for any one State in India and post-award the bidder is required to acquire the necessary license for the given State within a period of two months. In case bid is submitted by Joint Venture, all partners whose scope as per the delineation of responsibilities amongst JV partners includes execution of Works or part thereof at Site, should possess and/or acquire the necessary license as stated above
